

Day 1 Sunday 16 September

It was sunshine and blue skies for the Victorian team when they landed at Perth airport on Saturday 15/9.

The range faces north with no direct sunlight on the targets resulting in targets looking quite dull on a cloudy day.

**Facilities** in the main building are quite good with a large dining hall, bar, kitchen, shop, office and amenities block. For wet weather there is a large enclosed rifle cleaning area.

By Sunday afternoon cloud cover had increased along with the SWS wind bringing the chill factor down to around 17deg for what was supposed to be a sunny 22 deg day.

Following the range visit the team headed out to the nearby Duke Bar and Bistro for an early evening meal and back home for an early night in readiness for the early start on Monday morning.
